French Language Arts

This week in French Language Arts, the class reviewed the letters “a” and “i.” We continued our centers from last week and added two new ones: the listening and game centers. At the game center, students will practice their vocabulary and spelling while playing with a partner or alone. At the listening center, students will listen to stories, songs or poems and answered questions.

Units of Inquiry

As the students are getting ready to create their crest, the grading rubric was explained to them. The final crest must be as neat as possible, have four or more elements representing them and the students should be able to explain why each element represents them. In English, students shared their me bags and explained which shapes represents them. In French, the students chose colors and animals representing them and explained why.

English Language Arts

This week in Reading, we learned that we can reread our favorite books to notice new details. In Phonics, we focused on digraphs, two letters that come together to make one sound. Then, we solved some riddles from Rasheed to using our new knowledge of digraphs. In writing, we began editing our small moment stories by focusing on punctuation and learning from our favorite writers.

Math

This week in math, we played games to improve our subtraction fluency. We also completed story problems that involved subtraction. We discussed strategies for solving the problems and practiced using numbers, pictures and words to represent a solution to a problem. We also practiced using standard notation (- and =) to represent subtraction equations.
