Dear Families,

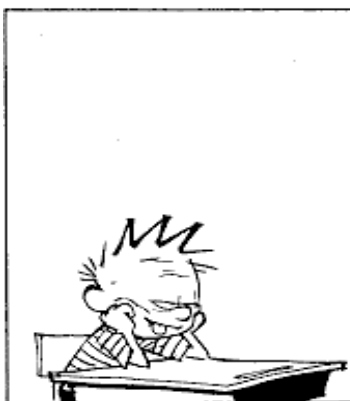
