This week in English students have been practicing finding the main idea along with 3 supporting details of nonfiction texts. Scholars have also been working on vocabulary, main idea, and reading comprehension during ELA time in centers. In Spanish Language Arts students worked on reading comprehension and vocabulary with texts on natural resources. In math students are learning about the different types of subtraction word problems and using their own problem solving strategies to determine this. Scholars are also practicing subtraction strategies and their math mantra for this unit is: Equation. Solve. Answer. In units of inquiry students have been exploring how people meet their needs over time or how our economy has changed over time by comparing the natural, capital, and labor resources for hunter gatherers and agriculturalists.
